

Getting Started with MY-SCHOOL

Logging In

Log in using your existing C2k Username and Password

MY-SCHOOL automatically loads once logged in.

There are 2 MY-SCHOOL interfaces:

Standard: All Staff and Post Primary

Pupils

Learning Exchange

Primary: All Primary Pupils

MY-SCHOOL Interface

The standard MY-SCHOOL interface is divided into 3 areas:

The Banner - displays the school name:

• Click **Customise** to select different Themes for your MY-SCHOOL

The Tab area (main part of screen):

- Will display any notices/messages sent to you via MY-SCHOOL
- My Home tab displays standard widgets such as Clock, Google Search etc – users cannot change the content of their My Home tab
- Click New Tab to create your own tabs and add your own widgets (refer to

Customising Tabs and Using the Widget Library in the Learning Exchange)

My Panel (right of screen):

- The Launch panel displays 9 commonly used launch buttons
- Click View All to see all available launch buttons.

The first 3 launch buttons are:



Click **MyApps** to access software. Software is categorized into curriculum tabs.

SIMS.net, Microsoft Office products are available in the **Tools** tab in MyApps



Click **Fronter** to access

Fronter is the C2k Regional Virtual Learning Environmnet



Equella is a digital content manager repository: a central storage area for resources by C2k, Schools, and other education organisations

Click Equella to access

Staff users also have common programs such as SIMS.net, MS Word and MS Outlook 'pinned' to the task bar (beside Start button) for easy access.

Software is also accessible from the **MyApps** button in the System Tray when working in school on a C2k Managed device.

Accessing Documents & Files

NB: The **MYFiles** launch button is used to access your files and documents **when you are not connected to your school network**, eg at home or on a BYOD.

<u>To access your files in school</u> (on a C2k Managed device)

Click Start in the bottom left of the screen



- Click **Documents** to open your My Documents area. (Your documents are saved in the N:\ drive as before)
- Click Computer to access your shared areas, eg Staff (T:\) and Shared Resources (W:\) drives.


To access your files on a device not connected to the school network, eg from home, refer refer to the information sheet **EN024** on C2k Exchange.

Access from Home/Bring your own Device

To access MY-SCHOOL, including MYFiles and Outlook Web Access (OWA email) from home use URL:

NB When connecting a C2k Teacher laptop to home wi-fi it is necessary to change Internet Settings:

Open Internet Explorer

- Select Tools | Internet Settings and click the Connections tab
- Click LAN Settings
- Under Proxy Server, untick Use a proxy server for your LAN
- Click **OK** and **OK** again

To connect the C2k Teacher Laptop to school network, repeat this process and ensure the **Use** a proxy server for your LAN setting is ticked. For more information refer to Information Sheet **EN025** available on C2k Exchange.

Launch buttons are available in the Launch panel to access **Fronter** and **Equella**:
